



A Bylaw to regulate the Parking of Vehicles
in Designated Disabled Parking Zones.

The Council Of The Village Of Torquay, In The Province Of
Saskatchewan, Enacts As Follows:

INTERPETATION:

1. (a) " Disabled Parking Zone" means that a portion of a public highway adjacent to the curb, designated ,by signs and or markings for the exclusive use of vehicles designated as being operated or carrying as passengers, disabled persons.
- (b) " Curb " means the lateral boundries of a roadway, weather or not marked by curbing.
- (c) " Highway" means any street or public highway within the Village.
- (d) " Penalties" means any person who contravenes any of the provisions set out in this Bylaw, is guilty of an offense, and shall become liable on conviction to the penalties provided for in Section 3 Subsection 1-4 of this Bylaw.

PARKING:

2. (1) No person shall park a vehicle unless it has a license plate designation indicating the vehicle is operated or carrying a disabled person, in any designated parking areas as listed in Appendix " A " of this Bylaw.
- (2) Section 1 Subsection B Bylaw 42-67, does not apply to any vehicles that are disgnated as being operated by or carry disabled persons.

PENALTIES:

3. (1) Any persons who contravenes any provisions of Section 2 Subsection (1), (2) of this Bylaw, is guilty of an offense and liable upon summmary conviction to a penalty of not less than \$ 20.00 (Twenty Dollars) and not greater than \$ 100.00 (One Hundred Dollars) that shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Village, to be used for public use. This shall be paid within Fifteen Days (15) Days, at the Village Office in Torquay.
- (2) Any member of the police force, special constable or other persons appointed by council, may remove or cause to be removed any vehicle that is unlawfully parked in a designated " Disabled Zone", and impound or store such vehicle.
- (3) Where a vehicle has been impounded or stored after it has been removed under subsection (2), it may be retained for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of the removal, unless impounding and storage are sooner paid. Upon payment of the full costs herein, the vehicle may be released to the owner thereof.



(4) If costs of removal ,impounding or storage is not paid with in Thirty (30) days as specified in subsection (3) above,the municipality shall have the right to recover the same from the owner by:

(a) Legal Action.

(b) Sale by public auction on publication of notice designating the time and place of sale at least ten days prior to sale,in a newspaper circulating in the municipality and or by sending notice by registered mail to the owner at the address appearing on the last registration of the vehicle.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This bylaw shall come into effect,after the third reading and adoption by the Council of The Village Of Torquay.
