



A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF TORQUAY TO ESTABLISH THE TORQUAY RECREATION BOARD:

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TORQUAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

There shall be appointed by the Council a Recreation Board, which shall be known as the RECREATION BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF TORQUAY.

Such a Board shall consist of a minimum of EIGHT MEMBERS, to be appointed by resolution of Council, as follows.

- A) ONE (1) MEMBER OF COUNCIL
- B) ONE (1) MEMBER OF THE R.M. OF CAMBRIA COUNCIL
- C) SIX (6) MEMBERS AT LARGE FROM THE VILLAGE OF TORQUAY & THE R.M. OF CAMBRIA #6

At the first appointment of the Board Members, the terms of office shall appoint another person to take the place of the retiring officer, a retiring officer may be reappointed to the Board.

The Board Members at their First Meeting in each year may appoint a Secretary Treasurer, Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson. If a member of the Board absents himself for three consecutive meetings of the board, unless excused by resolution of the board, or his seat becomes vacant by death, resignation, or otherwise, then on being notified by the board of a vacancy the Council, by resolution appoints a person for the remainder of the term.

All orders of proceedings of the Board, shall be kept in a book, for the purpose and signed by the Chairman or Secretary of the Board.

The financial year of the Recreation Board, shall commence on the first day of January in each year, and close on the Thirty-First day of December in each year.

Four Members shall constitute a Quorum.

The Board, shall meet at least Four (4) times in each year, or as many times that is necessary in a year.

The Board may make recommendations to Council on all Bylaws, rules or regulations as it deems necessary, on all matters and things connected with regulations, management supervision, and operation of the program, areas, facilities and equipment under its control, as set down by the Council.

The Board, shall have the management, control, and operation of programs, facilities and equipment which may from time to time be designated by the resolution of the Council.

The Board, shall on or before the 15th day of February in each year prepare and submit in writing to Council a detailed report of all the year's programs, plus the projection on all things mentioned such as needs regarding areas, facilities, and equipment with an attached budget regarding all items mentioned in the report.


The Board, shall be responsible to the Council, for all the allocations of all monies and no expenditures shall be in excess of any individual project, without permission by resolution to the Council.

In addition to other duties as recited, it shall be the duty of the Recreation Board to:


- A) Recommend to the Council and to the Community Planning Committee suitable sights, alterations improvements to the present areas or facilities and needed equipment of the community and district.
- B) Direct Councils attention to, and suggest possible solutions for any part of areas, facilities or equipment which might be hazardous to the health and safety of the public.
